
OBJECTIVES





Fig. 3 Map with locations of both venues

HOW TO GET TO SKOPJE

By plane



Skopje International Airport is reachable from most capital European cities. The venues are situated approx. 26 km west of the Skopje International Airport - the biggest airport of North Macedonia. Please check their web site for more info at: http://skp.airports.com.mk.

Public transport from the Skopje International Airport to the city centre



Bus transport is available every day from the city center to Skopje International Airport and vice versa, during the entire year. Transport is organized according to a predetermined timetable and it has 3 stops along the route:

- 1. Holiday Inn Hotel
- 2. Transport Center
- 3. Capitol Mall Municipality "Aerodrom"
- 4. Skopje International Airport

The timetable is adjusted in accordance with the airport flight timetable and the latest version is available at the website of Skopje International Airport: http://skp.airports.mk.

The price per one-way ticket is 150 denars (2.5 €).

If there are any delays of the flights, the bus transportation shall be organized accordingly.



LOCAL INFORMATION

Facts

Skopje is the capital and the largest city of the Republic of Macedonia. It covers an area of 1854 km², 23km in longitude and 9km in latitude and is situated at 245 metres above the sea level. The estimated population is 545.000. The time zone is UTC+1 (CET).

Skopje is located in the north of the North Macedonia, in the center of the Balkan peninsula. Several mountains surround the city: Vodno with its summit Krstovar (1.066 m), the massive Jakupica - Karadzica with its summit Solunska Glava - Mokro (2.450 m) and Ubava (2.533 m), Osoj 1.506 m, Zheden 1.260 m and Skopska Crna Gora with its summit Ramno (1.561 m). The longest river in the country, river Vardar runs through the city. Its length from the Vrutok spring to its estuary in the Aegean Sea is about 410 km. There are 2 artificial lakes nearby, Matka and Treska.

Climate

The weather in Skopje in January is generally cold. Rain and snow can be significant and the average air temperature is between -4°C and +4°C. The mornings might be very cold and icy on the streets, so great care is needed when walking on foot.

Currency and Money Exchange

The monetary unit in North Macedonia is denar (ден.). Euro (€) is not generally accepted as currency in most places. Foreign currency can be exchanged at the airport or at the banks. Foreign exchange rate listed from the National Bank of the Republic of Macedonia: 1 Euro (€) = 61.5 denars.

All major Credit Cards, such as MasterCard, Visa, American Express are accepted in most hotels, restaurants and shops. Banks are open Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 17:00.

Electricity Supply

In North Macedonia the electrical power is 220 volts AC, 50 cycles. A round-pin adaptor is necessary for electrical appliances.




Smoking Ban

Smoking is forbidden in enclosed places of work in R. Macedonia. This includes office blocks, various buildings, public houses/bars and restaurants and company vehicles. Smoking will not be permitted indoors at the meeting place. Some hotels have rooms for smokers.
