Summary

This report is about candidate application to Open call for research projects from UNMO, Center for research. Center has opened the call for researchers and companies in two new international research projects and accepted in total 8 applicants.





1. Preparation of the call

As a part of the Work Package 4 (WP4) Trials, Pilot & Review of Erasmus + programme "Promoting academia-industry alliances for R&D through collaborative and open innovation platform - All4R&D", Dzemal Bijedic University of Mostar (UNMO), ei. newly established Center for research prepared two research projects:

- Assessment and strengthening strategies of historical buildings "Partizan" sport ground a case study
- Methodology for quality control and principles for repair of concrete structures –
 Velez stadium a case study

On 27. January 2021. two finalized projects proposals were presented by Marko Ćećez at 7th Management Meeting. It was agreed to launch call for participation of young researchers and companies based on presented projects.

Target groups for the projects were:

- Individuals: MSc or PhD Students in civil engineering or architecture
- Companies from construction industry

For individuals, obligative documents were:


- Motivation letter:
- Letter of reference for young researchers working at companies;
- Formal document proofing that a person is civil engineering or architecture student of second year of II cycle or a PhD student.

For companies, obligative documents were:

- Motivation letter;
- Company profile

In addition to obligative documents, additional conditions were anticipated:

 Written confirmation of the participant that he/she does not expect any salary, cover of living costs, cover of travel costs or any other payment for participation in the research project,





- Written statement that he/she during work on research project will respect rules and procedures of Faculty of Civil engineering and its Institute,
- Written statement that he/she will take care of him/herself on the project site and be solely responsible for any injury or accident on ruined buildings location if it happens

Total number of individual participants was 4. In case of greater number of participants, interviews would be carried out.

The call was launched on 19. February 2021., and final deadline for application was 05. April 2021.

The projects will start on 15. April 2021, with duration of 12 months.

The call was published on All4R&D project Platform web site, Faculty of Civil Engineering (section of Center for research) web site and on social media (Figures).




Figure 1. The call on Civil Engineering (UNMO) Facebook page






Figure 1. The call on Students Union (UNMO) Facebook page





Figure 3. The call on All4R&D Facebook page






Figure 4. The call on All4R&D Twitter page

In total 8 applications were submitted to Center for research.


For the project "Assessment and strengthening strategies of historical buildings – "Partizan" sport ground a case study" the applicants are:
